### LEGAL OPINION

#### Injunction

An injunction can be revoked where we have a final judgment on the main lawsuit against the defendant; if we have a judgment on the main lawsuit in favour of the defendant; in case of compromise; and if 30 days lapse from completion of the tribunal.

Further, the plaintiff seeking the injunction, is under the duty to file the main lawsuit within 30 days from the date the injunction was imposed.

In case where the injunction is granted, subsequent resignation from the main lawsuit, does not suggest the injunction is automatically rendered void. Revocation of the injunction should be sought through a separate procedure.
