## LEGAL OPINION

### Maritime Claims Tribunals

Disputes arising from activity related to shipping are submitted to the Maritime Claims Tribunals, located in Piraeus, for cases which arise in Attica prefecture.

Maritime claims concern those related to sea commerce and to the use, operation, and operation of a vessel.

In case a maritime claim is submitted to a Court other than the above competent Court of Piraeus, relevant consideration can be raised at any stage of the dispute, even before the Supreme Court.
